The Human Rights Measurement Framework (HRMF) has been developed by the Commission, in partnership with the Scottish Human Rights Commission, to bring together information and evidence for analysing and assessing human rights in Britain. It will enable the Commissions, Government, public bodies, NGOs and others with an interest in human rights to begin to evaluate compliance with, and progress towards, the implementation of human rights in England, Scotland and Wales. The ‘prototype’ framework covers five rights that are domestically enforceable under the Human Rights Act, and three rights from international instruments that the UK is signed up to.
